Annenberg Radio News, Watt Way digital magazine and the Metamorphosis Project at USC's Annenberg School for Communication are teaming up to produce multimedia journalism projects from South Los Angeles neighborhoods.

The goal is to create a two-way street for South L.A. communities and the media; to generate more, much-needed stories; and to train a new generation of journalists for open-minded, culturally literate reporting.

Students working with the project will produce stories in print, broadcast and online forms. Stories will also increasingly appear in Spanish and Korean. The project will incorporate research conducted by the Metamorphosis Project for more substantive discussions about minority, ethnic and immigrant communities across Los Angeles.

By encouraging more media attention in South L.A., reaching out to communities and listening to their stories, Intersections hopes to become a much-needed resource. Eventually, Intersections has the potential to become a news service for mainstream media outlets, providing a range of stories from South L.A.
